

IN-COUNTRY SCHOLARSHIP

The Bangsamoro Development Agency (BDA) in partnership with the Australian AID announces the opening for the In-Country Scholarship Program (ICSP 2).

The Department of Foreign and Trade (DFAT) through Philippines-Australia Human Resource and Organisational Development Facility (PAHRODF) is opening the Phase 2 of In-Country Scholarship Program.

This program aims to build potential leaders and increases technical professionals for Filipino-Bangsamoros primarily in conflict affected areas in Mindanao.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Filipino citizen from Mindanao and is committed to work for the development of the Bangsamoro
- 2. Must have a cumulative work experience of a least two (2) years, either in public or private sector.
- 3. Must have finished a four-year bachelor's degree program.
- 4. Must have not been the subject of any disciplinary actions that warranted suspension or expulsion from your employees, (A certification of no pending administrative case from employer is required.)
- 5. Not a beneficiary of any scholarship or other education assistance program at the time of application or during the duration of the scholarship,
- 6. Must pass the program entry requirements of the academic institution where you intend to enroll.

Applicants seeking for an endorsement letter from our office should provide a photocopy (Authenticated) of the following documents to BDA:

- NSO Birth Certificate
- 2. Voter's ID/Barangay Clearance
- 3. Transcript of Records and Diploma
- 4. Police Clearance
- 5. NBI Clearance
- 6. One (1)- page concept paper (Outlining the relevance of the chosen program/field of study to your current employment and how the newly acquire knowledge and skills will be used to the development of Bangsamoro Development priorities)
- 7. Employment Certification, for employed person (No conviction or pending administrative case)

Deadline for the submission of the documents is on **January 31, 2016**. ICSP aspirants who complied with the above requirements should undergo a written essay examination at the nearest BDA office in your areas.

Furthermore, the partner organizations (BDA, BMLI & DepEd-ARMM) of the In-Country Scholarship Program conducted meeting last January 7, 2016. It was firmed-up that they will endorse aspirants under their respective Priority Fields of Study. It was agreed that aspirants who wanted to avail Education-related courses should obtain their endorsement letter from DepEd ARMM and at least an eligible or LET Passer.
